Conditions for all applicants

- 1 Temporary Membership is issued for a maximum period of two weeks, but this may be extended in exceptional circumstances.
- 2 Applicants can only be proposed/seconded by paid-up Members of at least 6 months standing.
- 3 Two clear days must elapse between nomination and admission.
- 4 Temporary Membership Cards may be collected from the bar.

Applicant's normal permanent place of residence must be a distance greater than 25 miles from the Club. Proof of this will be required by the Bar Staff before the Temporary Membership card is issued.
